Volunteer Money Mentors:

- Are trained to assist all, regardless of reading ability or material resources
- Serve as a positive role model and friend, keeping strict confidentiality
- Build trust as you use tools to develop financial skills
- Strive for mutual respect, build self-esteem and motivation
- Help set goals and work toward accomplishing them
- Are at least 21 years of age, and agree to a criminal history check
- Are willing to adhere to all program policies and procedures
- Are willing to complete the application, screening and training process
- Are dependable and consistent in meeting time commitments
- Commit about 6 hours a month, for at least 6 months duration of mentoring
